## ANTIQUE 40 colour enhancer

### Description

**ANTIQUE 40** is wet look sealer to be used when one wants to avoid etching either of a sandblasted or of a rough surface. stones treated with **ANTIQUE 40** take a warm colour shade and the natural veins are extremely enhanced. The product can be used for indoor as well for outdoor surfaces. Furthermore, as a consequence of the treatment with **ANTIQUE 40**, surfaces also get stain-proof features.

### Application

Apply the product with a brush. On fine honed surfaces, apply just a little product with a cloth trying to avoid product accumulations.

### Maintenance

For periodic maintenance of indoor surfaces, wash the floor with CLEANER 53 neutral pH cleaner. Every 6-8 months or when needed, clean the surface, then apply the maintenance wax WAX 63.

### Caution

Flammable product. Provide adequate room ventilation when used in confined spaces. Avoid sources of heat and flame. Protect eyes and skin from contact. Do not ingest.

### Fortuitous leakage and waste disposal method

In case material is released or spilled, clean up the most of the product and neutralize. Absorb any residue with sand, sawdust etc. Store the residue in metal tanks and call for a specialized company.

**Coverage:** 12-18 m<sup>2</sup>/lt.

**Storage:** Keep the tin closed and in a cool place.

**Shelf life:** 1-2 years

**Packing:** 1 L. bottle (12 per carton) - 5 L. tin (4 per carton) - 10 L. cans - 25/60 L. drum
